The Kanda Secondhand Book Festival is a special event in Tokyo for people who  books. It takes place every autumn in the Jimbocho neighborhood, often called “Book Town.” Jimbocho is home to over 150 bookstores, many of which sell rare, antique, or academic books. This makes it a popular place for book lovers, collectors, and curious visitors.

The festival runs from late October to early November and draws thousands of people every year. During this time, Yasukuni-dori Ⓐ transforms into a lively open-air book market. Long rows of outdoor bookshelves line the street, offering over one million books for sale. You can find many types of books, including classic literature, history, manga, art books, and foreign-language editions. Ⓑ It’s easy to spend hours exploring the stalls and discovering treasures.

First held in 1960, the festival has become a beloved\* tradition in Tokyo. In addition to , it features special exhibitions, talks by authors, and events hosted by local bookstores and publishers. Many of the bookstores offer discounts or display rare volumes, making it a perfect time to look for unique or hard-to-find titles at good prices.

The festival’s charm comes from its lively atmosphere. Jimbocho is a lovely neighborhood with a Ⓒ rich literary history, and during the event, the streets are filled with excitement and the busy conversations of happy bibliophiles\*. Nearby cafés and restaurants join in, offering special book-themed\* menus and displays, which all adds to the festive mood\*.

So if you love books, and are planning to be in Tokyo in the , be sure to visit the Kanda Secondhand Book Festival. Whether you are looking for a specific title or just want to enjoy the atmosphere, this festival offers an unforgettable experience.
