My grandfather had a remarkable life. He was able to witness changes in the world  $\overline{\mathcal{T}}$  beyond what most people experience in a single lifetime. He was born on November 22, 1899, on a cotton farm in what is now the state of Oklahoma. There, his childhood was spent with almost none of the technology we are familiar with today. For example, to get to school, he had to ride a horse along dirt trails.

He said he could remember the first time he saw a train. Not long after that, automobiles arrived. Later, jet airplanes took him to distant countries, and, in his seventh decade, he watched a rocket take men to the Moon.

He had always hoped that his life would, as he <u>Aput</u> it, "span\* three centuries." If he lived to see the year 2001, he would see the nineteenth, twentieth and twenty-first centuries. Sadly, he passed away two months before reaching his goal.

While I, too, have seen impressive changes in the world, sometimes I try to put myself in his shoes\*. <sub>®</sub>I join him, in my imagination, watching in amazement at that first steam locomotive arriving in his small town.

I envy my grandfather, \( \frac{1}{1} \) had the chance to experience the arrival of so many wonders of the modern world. Unlike me, he could see them with fresh eyes, before they came to be taken for granted.

Visiting the Serengeti National Park\* in Tanzania is a once-in-a-lifetime experience, offering the ultimate African safari. The best months to visit are from June to September, the time of the Great Wildebeest Migration\*.

( X ) this period, the first couple of months are considered to be ideal for wildlife viewing, as the grass is shorter then, and more animals can be seen. Individual safari itineraries\* can be planned to focus on specific\* interests, such as bird watching, cultural encounters, walks, or climbs.

The most popular way to explore the Serengeti is driving in an open vehicle. These drives, led by expert guides, are usually undertaken in the early morning or the late afternoon, to <u>Atake advantage of</u> the cooler temperatures during those times of day. Such a schedule not only suits the visitors, but also the animals, as they are most active at dawn and at dusk.

(Y) drives, there are many other activities that you can do to experience the true Serengeti. For example, there are guided walking safaris in the western part of the park. 

<u>BGetting out of a vehicle and exploring the land on foot provides a better sense of how the animals live, and what their habits are.</u> Furthermore, on foot there is a chance to learn about the bush survival skills of the local human population.

As an alternative to walking, how about flying? Another popular activity is taking a dawn hot air balloon ride to watch the huge numbers of animals moving over the vast ©plain below.

And for those who wish to learn more about the people of the region, there are guided tours of Maasai villages. (Z) one of these tours, you will be able to talk to the local residents and learn something about their customs, beliefs and traditions.
